Sexual assault is the full range of FORCED SEXUAL ACTS including kissing, touching, verbally coerced sex, and physically forced vaginal, oral, or anal sex.

90% OF ASSAULTS ARE **NOT REPORTED** TO POLICE

Sexual violence can result in numerous physical and mental health consequences for survivors, such as: depression, lowered self-esteem, unplanned pregnancy, and/or sexually transmitted infections. Survivors may use alcohol and/or drugs to cope with their experiences.
