Gentamicin 40 mg/mL (2 mL) 3 vials/pkg	Alternate dual treatment with Azithromycin for cases and contacts of Gonorrhea Infection (for individuals with a cephalosporin allergy or anaphylaxis reaction to penicillin)				
Doxycycline 100 mg tablets 14 tabs/pkg	Alternate for treatment of syphilis; cases & contacts of chlamydia and co-treatment for cases and contacts of gonorrhea				
Cefixime 400 mg tablets 2 tabs/pkg	<i>Alternative dual treatment with Azithromycin for cases & contacts of gonorrhea infection</i>				
Amoxicillin 500 mg capsules 21 caps /bottle	<i>Alternative treatment for pregnant and nursing mothers with chlamydia,</i>
