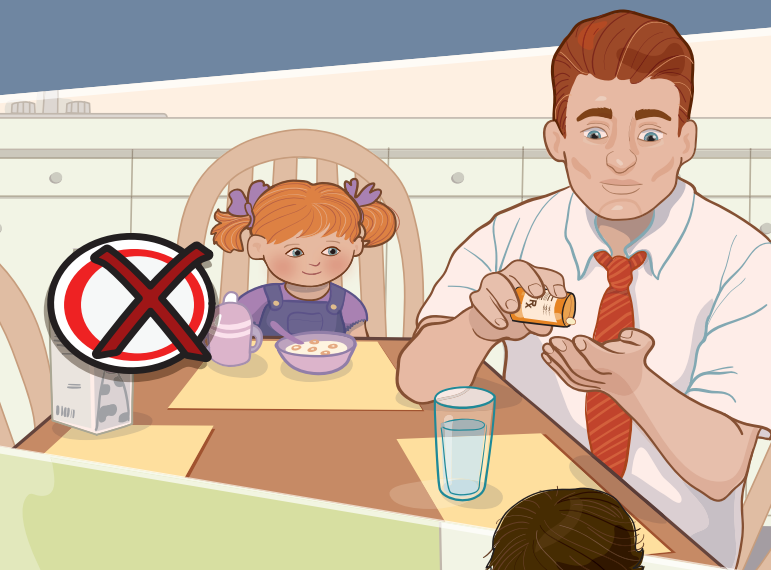




PROTECT CHILDREN FROM MEDICATION POISONING



MEDICATION IS INVOLVED IN 81% OF POISONING-RELATED HOSPITALIZATIONS IN CHILDREN UNDER 5 YEARS OF AGE.

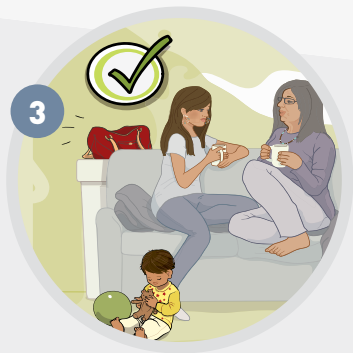
Over 600 Saskatchewan children under the age of five were hospitalized due to an unintentional poisoning between 2004 and 2013.



Store all medications locked up tight and out of sight. Many children can open "child resistant" containers.



Take your medications where children can't see you. Sometimes children copy the actions of adults in their lives.



Keep visitors' bags and coats out of reach. Some people carry their medications with them.
