What's in your bag?

Prescription Medications:

May cause a wide variety of minor to serious problems depending on the product.

Mouthwash:

Often contains alcohol. May cause low blood sugar, sleepiness and impairment.

Chocolate Laxatives:

May cause severe diarrhea.

Pain Medicine:

May cause sleepiness, nausea, vomiting and affects breathing.

Eye Drops:

May cause sleepiness, racing or slowed heart rate (depending on ingredients) and difficulty breathing.

Hand Sanitizer:

Often contains alcohol. May cause low blood sugar, sleepiness and impairment.

Prescription Medications:

May cause a variety of minor to serious symptoms depending on product.

Toothpaste:

May cause upset stomach if swallowed.

Cigarettes:

May cause severe vomiting, upset stomach, choking and seizures.

Over-the-counter medicine:

May cause sleepiness, irritability and agitation.
